# Approval of the Open Meeting Minutes

Executive Secretary Report: Panama is releasing sterile male screwworm flies to mate with females which is a common practice to help eradicate the disease.

Board Member Report: Dr. Sato reported on the HPAI grant challenge Grand Challenge was due last week. There were over 400 applications submitted.

#### Financial Report

Dr. Kaisand reported the Board's financial status for FY25 with the current balance of \$231,798.36. Dr. Kaisand reported that IT is looking at different computer options for the

Board Members and providing remote access to the Iowa Board of Veterinary Medicine computer drive.

# **Executive Secretary Report**

Dr. Kaisand reported Iowa Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship posted a memo on the website about the Asian Longhorn Tick that was found in Iowa. The symptoms are very similar to anaplasmosis. The Asian Longhorn Tick is a reportable disease, and a PCR test is used to diagnose the disease. Dr. Shuey reported his clinic had a farm deer case last year that Iowa State University Veterinary Diagnostic Lab diagnosed as an Asian Longhorn Tick.

The Tuberculosis/Brucellosis eradiation vaccination fund was not funded by the Governor's office. This fund will reimburse the veterinarian until June 30, 2025, after that the producer will have to pay for the vaccinations.

The department has a Tuberculosis trace investigation from cattle moved to lowa with animal exposure.

The USDA is rolling out plans to try and prevent the Screwworm from entering the United States by inspecting all cattle, bison, and equine at all border crossings and building a dispersal facility in Texas to breed and release sterile male flies. There are a few other plans the USDA is developing.

Dr. Kaisand presented to the Board Members a slide show of the Veterinary Technician State Examination that was given prior to the new format.
