***Eligibility for broodmare residency shall be achieved by meeting at least one of the following rules:

- 1. Thirty days' residency until the foal is inspected by a department inspector, if in foal to a Registered Iowa Stallion.
- 2. Thirty days' residency until the foal is inspected by a department inspector, for broodmares which are bred back to registered stallions.
- 3. Thoroughbred mares; Continuous residency from December 15 until the foal is inspected by a department inspector if the mare was bred by other than an lowa registered stallion and which is not bred back to an lowa registered stallion.
- 4. Quarter Horse and Standardbred mares; Continuous residency from January 31 until the foal is inspected by a department inspector if the mare was bred by other than an lowa registered stallion and which is not bred back to an lowa registered stallion.

The one-time broodmare registration will cover the mare her entire productive life as long as there is not a change of ownership (at which time a mare transfer form must be completed) and she meets the aforementioned eligibility rules.

***** MARE AND FOAL MAY NOT LEAVE THE STATE OF IOWA UNTIL INSPECTED BY A DEPARTMENT INSPECTOR. *****
