

## Checklist for Aerial Application Job

- 1. Field location maps:**
  - County, township and section       or latitude/longitude if available
  - Field boundaries clearly marked
  - Nearby sensitive areas identified:
    - Registered bee hives
    - Organic crops
    - Vineyards
    - Orchards
    - Endangered species locations (Topeka shiner, prairie bush clover, etc.)
    - Water bodies (streams, lakes, ponds)
    - Dwellings or residential areas adjoining field of application
    - Adjoining fields where farm workers could be present (oats/hay fields, seed corn fields, vegetable crops)
    - Roads
    - Other places occupied by people (campgrounds, schools, athletic fields, parks, bike trails, etc)
    - Local events/celebrations (July 4<sup>th</sup>, RAGBRAI, County Fairs, etc)
    - Maps approved by consultant are reviewed with applicator.
- 2. Pesticide Label.**
  - Applicator has copy of label.
  - Applicator has read and understands label instructions:
  - Do not apply in a manner that drifts to people.
  - Environmental Precautions ( Do not apply directly to water, toxic to bees)
  - Application and dilution rates
  - PPE requirements
  - Drift precautions
  - Nozzle types and configuration
