Dear Friends:

Congratulations on becoming a recipient of the Century Farm Award. A statewide Century Farms Award Ceremony will be held at the Iowa State Fair on **Thursday, August 18, 2022**, in honor of your family's contribution to the growth and stability of Iowa agriculture. The ceremony will be held at the historic air-conditioned Pioneer Livestock Pavilion – highlighted on the enclosed fairgrounds map. I have also included a diagram of the lay-out of the interior of the Pavilion. General information on the Iowa State Fair is also enclosed.

**THIS IS THE ONLY NOTIFICATION** your family will receive regarding your Century Farm. It is your responsibility to contact any other family member whose name was submitted as a present farm owner. Please return the enclosed Reply Card by **July 5, 2022**, notifying us of your intention to attend the ceremony. Family and friends are also welcome to attend. Please return the Reply Card by July 5th even if you are unsure of all those attending in your group. The return of your Reply Card also serves as an assurance to me that you have received your information packet.

**Please Check All of The Information on The Enclosed Reply Card Carefully.** This information will be printed in the Century Farms Ceremony Program and needs to be returned **immediately** in order to meet our printing deadline. The enclosed Reply Card lists the names of the **farm owners and location of the farm**. Also listed are the names that will be printed on your certificate. **Please check the spelling carefully.** An instructional worksheet is included to aid you in completing the postcard. **Return this card by July 5, 2022.**

**You must “check in”** with our registration table when you arrive the day of the ceremony. It will be located at the south entrance of the Pavilion. Please go to the table that is designated with your Century Farm County name above it. Registration will be divided into four separate time slots, alphabetically by county.

**Check the Enclosed Registration and Presentation Time Schedule That Applies to Your Century Farm County.**

The **awards ceremony** will be divided into two groupings – morning and afternoon - alphabetically by counties. The groupings are based on **the county in which the Century Farm is located**. The awards presentation will start with counties beginning with the letter “A” and continue alphabetically by county.

During the ceremony, you will be asked to come forward to receive your award. **The stage is handicapped accessible.** Your photograph will be taken as you receive the award. You may designate someone to receive the award on your behalf if you are unable to attend the ceremony.


### **You will receive:**

1. A complimentary 5 x 7 photo which will be sent to you following the ceremony. This picture is not copyrighted.
2. An award certificate. Please note that each couple and individual listed as a titleholder will receive a certificate.
3. Each farm will receive one metal marker.

Additional certificates and photographs may be ordered at the order table the **day of the ceremony only**. Cash or checks will be accepted (no credit cards, please). Additional markers will be available for purchase at the order desk the day of the ceremony.

### **Prices:**

- Additional certificates are \$7.00 each.
- Additional photos are \$6.00 each.
- A postage and handling fee of \$4.00 is added to each order of certificates & photos.
- Metal markers are \$7.00 each if picked up at the State Fair. Metal markers are \$17.00 each if mailed.

After September 19, 2022, you will be able to access your individual family photos on our website at [www.iowaagriculture.gov](http://www.iowaagriculture.gov). Click on the Flickr icon at the lower right-hand corner of the home page  Click on “Albums” and then click on “Century Farms” or “Heritage Farms”. Scroll to your photo and click on it. In the lower right-hand corner, you have the option to “share” or “download” and print your own photos. As these are not copyrighted photos, you may print as many as you would like. This will be an easy way to share your photo with family members.

**For those unable to attend the ceremony.** Your certificate(s) and metal marker will be mailed to you after the State Fair, along with a copy of the program from the ceremony. If you wish to purchase additional certificates or markers, you may do so at that time. An order form will be sent to you along with your certificate.

We recommend that you purchase at least one additional certificate in the event the original is destroyed or lost. Certificates cannot be replaced. Metal markers can be replaced if it becomes necessary due to theft, age, or outdoor elements.

**Newspaper Notification.** Following the State Fair, a press release will be sent to all of the newspapers in the state with a list of all Century Farm recipients along with information on how to receive a copy of the photo taken at the State Fair. It is strictly up to your local newspapers if they decide to print the story. **Contact your local newspapers directly if you want to be sure they print your story.**

**No Drop-Off Point.** The Pioneer Livestock Pavilion is not accessible for you to drive to and drop off family members. See the Iowa State Fair Information attached for information on the Blue Line Parking Shuttle and on-grounds transportation.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE FAIRGROUNDS:** The Iowa State Fairgrounds are located at East 30<sup>th</sup> Street and East University Avenue, 10 minutes east of downtown Des Moines. For GPS and online mapping services, use the address **3000 East Grand Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50317.**

The Fair suggests the following routes:

**Eastern Iowa:** From I-80 take Exit 141 (Hwy. 65 Bypass), travel south on Hwy. 65 to Exit 79 and head west on Hwy. 163 (E University Avenue) approximately three miles to the Fairgrounds. It is suggested that visitors enter the Fair parking lot at E 36<sup>th</sup> as a left-hand turn may not be allowed into the grounds at E 33<sup>rd</sup> at certain times.

**Northern Iowa:** From I-35, take I-235 to Exit 10A then head east on E University Avenue approximately four miles to the Fairgrounds.

**Western Iowa:** From I-235, take Exit 10A then head east on E University Avenue approximately four miles to the Fairgrounds.

**Southern Iowa:** From I-35, take IA 5/US 65 to Exit 79 then head west on E University Avenue approximately four miles to the Fairgrounds.

**ADA/DISABLED PARKING:** The largest area of parking reserved for visitors with ADA or accessible needs is located in the North Lot. Admission to this lot is through Gate #2 at East 33rd Street and East University Avenue. Vehicles with a DOT parking permit or a windshield place card designation will be directed to the reserved parking area north of Gate 15. Vehicle parking fee is \$10 on a space-available basis; some hard-packed surface parking is available; however, the age and the rolling nature of the terrain means most of the parking area is unpaved. Designated accessible parking spaces on main streets in the inner grounds will not be available during the Fair.

Parking personnel will do their best to direct accessible needs visitors' vehicles to the closest, most convenient parking available. As north parking lots fill on high attendance days, the Des Moines Police Department determines when outside gates to the Fairgrounds are opened and closed. When one gate closes, generally, another is opened to assist in keeping traffic congestion on city streets to a minimum.

### **On-Ground Transportation:**

**Courtesy Carts:** Golf cart mini-shuttle service (not wheelchair accessible) from north parking lots to inner gates is available. Golf carts are not available for rent.

**Blue Line Parking Shuttle:** Free shuttle that runs daily from 5:30 a.m. until 1:00 a.m. The Blue Line Parking Shuttle has 6 routine stops and will stop at Gates 13 and 15 for entry to the Fair. I have attached a map of the shuttle stops.

**SCOOTER and WHEELCHAIR RENTALS:** HomeTown Mobility is accepting reservations online at [www.htmia.com](http://www.htmia.com) or by calling 712-938-2029 from 9 a.m.- 5 p.m. Monday – Friday and all 11 days during the Fair. Call-in reservations will be charged a \$5 processing fee. A limited number of wheelchairs and scooters will be available for walk-up customers during the Fair on a first come, first serve basis. **Reservations will be accepted for full day scooter and wheelchair rentals only.** Reservations must be made 24 hours in advance. A security deposit of a driver's license is required at the time of pick-up for all rentals. Cancellations must be made at least 48 hours in advance to receive a full refund, less a \$5 cancellation fee. Rental locations are at Gates 8, 10, 11, 13 & 15.

**ASSISTED LISTENING DEVICES:** Available for the Penningroth Media Center Cattle Barn, **Pioneer Livestock Pavilion**, Richard O. Jacobson Exhibition Center, Sheep Barn Sale Ring and Swine Barn Sale Ring when the State Fair sound system is being used.
