

NOTICE-TO-BIDDERS

Wright Co. 2026 Batch and Build Edge-of-Field Project Wright County, Iowa

Sealed bids will be received by the Iowa Department of Agriculture & Land Stewardship, Division of Soil Conservation and Water Quality (Division), **via the Iowa Management of Procurement and Contracts System (IMPACS)**, until 3:00 PM local time, on Tuesday, October 6, 2026. The bid opening, open to the public, will be held through IMPACS at 3:00 PM local time, on Tuesday, October 6, 2026, when bids will be read aloud. Interested parties may call in to hear the bid opening using the Microsoft Teams call-in number: 1-469-998-7627 code:484912548#. Bids must be submitted on the appropriate bid forms provided and shall include a bid bond in the amount of ten percent (10%). Bidders must also be registered with the Iowa Department of Inspections, Appeals & Licensing.

This project includes 4 bioreactors and 7 saturated buffer structures located in Wright County, Iowa. The estimated cost range for this project is \$165,000-\$185,000. Some of the materials required for this project include: water control structures (WCS), woodchips, geotextile fabric, perforated and non-perforated piping, outlet structures, amidst other items. In general, the work involves, and is not limited to, excavation, earthwork, grading, mobilization, and seeding.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 11:00 AM, on September 22, 2026 at the Iowa State University Extension and Outreach - Wright County, 2302 Madison Ave B, Clarion 50525. Attendance at the pre-bid conference by prospective bidders is not mandatory but is encouraged.

The Plans and Construction Specifications governing the construction of the proposed improvements have been prepared by Jeremy Bril, P.E., IDALS, and are hereby made a part of this notice by reference and the proposed contract shall be executed in compliance therewith. Bidders who attend and sign-in to the pre-bid conference will be added to the plan holders list. Printed copies of specifications and plans will be provided to the successful bidder.

The successful bidder shall be required to furnish a Performance/Payment Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. The bidder to whom the contract is awarded will be required to execute the Contract, obtain the appropriate insurance coverage and the Performance Bond, provide their Iowa Department of Inspections, Appeals, & Licensing Public Registration Number, and complete the provided Construction Progress Schedule within fourteen (14) calendar days from the date when Notice-of-Award is delivered to the Bidder. Construction shall commence within 14 days after the Preconstruction Conference.
